

## **BLOOD BANK/TRANSFUSION MEDICINE**

The Department of Pathology at the University of Chicago is recruiting MD or MD/PhD faculty members for its Blood Bank/Transfusion Medicine Service. Academic rank and administrative responsibilities will be commensurate with experience. Clinical and educational responsibilities in this tertiary care setting include supervision of therapeutic apheresis and stem cell harvest procedures, evaluation of blood donors, transfusion reaction workups and blood serological workups, as well as training of pathology residents and fellows in an ACGME-approved fellowship program. This service will be moving in early 2013 into a state-of-the-art facility in a new hospital pavilion. Candidates certified by the American Board of Pathology in Blood Banking/Transfusion Medicine will be preferred. Experience in diagnostic coagulation is a plus, as is a research interest in the broadly defined field of transfusion medicine. Candidates must hold or be able to obtain an Illinois medical license.
