The Department of Pathology (<http://pathology.ucsd.edu>) seeks a clinical-track faculty member to join the Division of Laboratory Medicine and serve as Director of the Toxicology and Drug Analysis Laboratory and Associate Director of Clinical Chemistry Laboratories for the expanding UC San Diego Health System. Successful candidates must have the expertise to revitalize and develop a modern toxicology and drug analysis laboratory, utilizing advanced chromatographic, mass spectrometry, and pharmacogenomic approaches, and offer a broad array of therapeutic drug management and personalized medicine services to a growing regional referral program; candidate will also share clinical and administrative responsibilities in the Clinical Laboratories at the Medical Center campuses in San Diego (Hillcrest) and La Jolla (Thornton). In 2011, most routine and specialty laboratory services will be consolidated into the new state-of-the-art Center for Advanced Laboratory Medicine, located near the 10-story, \$664 million Jacobs Medical Center complex under development on the LaJolla-East Campus. Candidates must possess M.D., Ph.D., or M.D./Ph.D. degrees, and be board-certified/eligible by the American Board of Pathology or a diplomate of an accredited clinical laboratory subspecialty board; California licensure is also required. Preference will be given to individuals with significant prior clinical subspecialty work experience and fellowship training. Applicants should have strong academic credentials with a track record of basic, translational, or clinical research, and are expected to actively contribute to departmental educational programs including training of residents, fellows, graduate and medical students. Academic rank will be commensurate with experience and training. Salary will be consistent with established UCSD pay scales. UCSD is an AA/EOE with a strong institutional commitment to excellence through diversity.
