The Department of Pathology at Beth Israel Deaconess Medical Center is recruiting a full-time transfusion medicine specialist with an interest in HLA/histocompatibility. The Medical Center is a 613-bed tertiary care facility and a principal teaching hospital of Harvard Medical School. The blood bank, histocompatibility, and stem cell processing laboratories are well integrated components of our busy clinical laboratories which perform over 7,000,000 tests annually. Over the last five years, under new leadership, our department has dramatically expanded with respect to breadth and depth of clinical and research operations. We continue to seek new faculty of outstanding potential who share our vision of excellence in academic pathology. Our commitment to develop leaders in laboratory medicine is unparalleled and is our highest priority.

The successful candidate will join two full-time transfusion medicine specialists, managing a comprehensive transfusion medicine service which supports active clinical programs in transplantation (bone marrow and solid organ), general hematology and oncology, cardiovascular surgery, obstetrics and neonatology.

In addition to sharing clinical and administrative service responsibilities, the candidate will be expected to play an active role in our pathology training program and in the Harvard Fellowship Program in Transfusion Medicine. Applicants must hold an MD or MD/PhD degree in addition to subspecialty certification in Blood Banking/Transfusion Medicine, and be qualified to obtain a medical license in Massachusetts. Harvard Medical School faculty appointment (full-time) will be commensurate with experience.
