- Direct the chemistry technical manager, group leaders, and staff with respect to technical performance of biochemical tests and procedures.
- Provide technical support in chemistry areas in Regional Center Laboratories, Contracted pathology Laboratories, and Veterinary Laboratories as well as Lab Supportive Services and Urinalysis as needed.
- Ensure compliance with regulatory guidelines.
- Oversee quality assurance and proficiency testing.
- Provide education to medical and technical staff and participate in the Medical Technology Training Program as needed.
- Assist in development of department budget in cooperation with lab leadership.
- Participate in patient care through interaction with medical staff, pharmacy, and nursing.
- Participate at the local/national level in professional associations (AACC, NACB, etc).

Education/Experience:

- PhD degree in biochemistry, analytical chemistry or other biological science and post-doctoral training in Clinical Chemistry at an institution approved by the Commission on Accreditation in Clinical Chemistry (ComACC), and/or Board certification by the American Board of Clinical Chemistry or National Registry in Clinical Chemistry

OR

- MD with additional training in clinical chemistry and board certified or qualified in clinical pathology by the American Board of Pathology
- Preferred, but not required is five years of experience in a clinical laboratory setting.
- Education qualifications must be from a school whose accreditation is recognized by Marshfield Clinic.
