

Clinical Chemistry: India

We are currently inviting highly motivated Clinical Chemist applicants to our newest location in India opening in the Spring 2012. The candidate must have an M.D. and/or Ph.D. with appropriate board certification/eligibility; experience in a large hospital-based specialty service is beneficial, as is experience with CAP and JCAHO certifications.

Clinical responsibilities will include attending duties in a large hospital-based and reference clinical chemistry service covering all aspects of cutting edge clinical chemistry and automated testing; this will include toxicology, mass spec analyses, and proteomics. Other duties will include administrative interactions, teaching supervisors and technicians, and outreach activities to other laboratories and using physicians. Salary will be commensurate with experience. Eligibility for licensure or practice and work in India is required.
