

DIRECTOR OF MICROBIOLOGY

The **University of Wisconsin-Madison** Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine is recruiting for an academic molecular microbiologist to serve as the Director of Microbiology. Qualified candidates should possess an MD or MD/PhD, have experience in medical microbiology, and be board certified in CP or AP/CP as well as by the American Board of Medical Microbiology. Candidate must be qualified for unrestricted licensure for the practice of medicine in Wisconsin. Applicants should be experienced in molecular microbiology and culture-based diagnostic methods required for patient care in a tertiary/quaternary health care system including the University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics, American Family Children's Hospital and on- and off-site clinics. Candidates should have demonstrated ability to provide medical direction of the laboratory, to develop and implement new diagnostic tests and to interact with clinicians in an academic medical center environment.

The individual will be appointed as a member of the department at the Associate/Full Professor level on the tenure track. In addition to performing routine service work, the individual will be expected to continue or develop a research program and to mentor graduate students. There will be ample opportunity to work closely with members of the Division of Infectious Diseases, Pediatric Infectious Disease as well as other faculty in both the clinical and basic science departments within the medical center on collaborative research projects. The successful candidate will be expected to contribute to the mission of the department via active participation in research and teaching programs, training of residents and medical students, mentoring of trainees, and participation in continuing medical education programs. Salary will be competitive and commensurate with experience.
