

DIRECTOR OF TRANSFUSION SERVICES

The **University of Wisconsin-Madison** Department of Pathology and Laboratory Medicine is recruiting for a tenure track, academic Director of Transfusion Medicine. Qualified candidates should possess an MD or MD/PhD and be board certified in CP or AP/CP as well as in transfusion medicine. Candidate must be qualified for unrestricted licensure for the practice of medicine in Wisconsin. Expertise in a large hospital based blood bank and therapeutic apheresis is essential. The laboratory provides approximately 55,000 blood products annually to the University of Wisconsin Medical Center with support for comprehensive programs in cancer, transplantation and trauma.

Successful applicant will be expected to staff the blood bank and apheresis services for 2-4 months per year, oversee QA/QC activities, contribute actively to the teaching of residents, fellows, and medical students, mentor trainees, participate in continuing medical education programs and engage in scholarly research. Candidate will also be responsible for directing the ACGME-accredited transfusion medicine fellowship program. In addition to performing routine service work, the individual will be expected to continue or develop a research program and to mentor graduate students. Candidates will possess diagnostic, administrative, leadership and interpersonal skills and show a record of scholarly achievement appropriate to the rank of Associate/Full Professor (tenure track). Salary will be competitive and commensurate with experience.
