Call for Editor-in-Chief *American Journal of Clinical Pathology (AJCP)*

Job Description:

- The Editor-in-Chief will have responsibility for the overall strategic direction of AJCP, one of ASCP's most visible and important member benefits for its pathologist members.
- He/she will have responsibility for setting the editorial direction and presenting the most timely and significant research findings relating to both anatomic and clinical pathology. The individual selected for this volunteer, term-limited role will receive a monthly stipend and will be expected to devote approximately 10 hours per week of his/her time to *AJCP*.

Qualifications & Requirements:

- The successful candidate should have a medical degree (or both MD and PhD degrees) with a specialization in pathology (a strong preference will be given to those with clinical experience, combined with research or academic experience).
- He/she must have experience working with scientific, peer-reviewed journals; as an author, editor, editorial board member, or reviewer.
