

## **Hematopathology Faculty Position—UC San Diego**

The Department of Pathology (<http://pathology.ucsd.edu>) seeks a clinical track academic hematopathologist to join the Clinical Hematopathology Team in the Division of Laboratory Medicine. In 2011, most laboratory and pathology services will be consolidated into the state-of-the-art Center for Advanced Laboratory Medicine, located near the NCI-designated Moore's Cancer Center and the new 10-story Jacobs Medical Center, under development. Applicants should be committed to excellent patient care, teaching, and scholarly research. The position involves a wide range of clinical responsibilities as well as teaching medical students and residents. The UCSD environment supports opportunities for basic, translational, and clinical investigation and interaction with a host of exceptional investigators. Candidates must possess M.D. or M.D./Ph.D. degrees, be board-certified/eligible by the American Board of Pathology (subspecialty certification in hematopathology preferred). California licensure is required. Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with qualifications and based on UCSD scales.
