The appointee will guide the practice of clinical laboratory medicine and the provision of graduate and undergraduate medical education in this discipline, and will maintain and encourage scholarly activities in this area. The Pathology Department includes a strong, collegial group of 35 faculty in the Divisions of Anatomic, Clinical and Experimental Pathology. It hosts a thriving ACGME-accredited residency program and 4 accredited fellowship programs in pathology subspecialties. Faculty in the department also participate in graduate school programs. The Medical Center is fiscally stable and growing, and encompasses the Penn State Milton S. Hershey Medical Center (approx. 500 beds), Penn State Hershey Cancer Institute, Penn State Hershey Children's Hospital, an outpatient surgery center, and multiple nearby research and clinic facilities. Clinical programs include the full spectrum of medical and surgical disciplines.
