The Department of Pathology at the University of Pittsburgh is seeking an Assistant/Associate Professor (tenure stream or nontenure depending on qualifications and extent of research effort) for the Division of Hematopathology. Academic and clinical interests in hematopoietic disorders, bone marrow pathology and laboratory hematology are encouraged. The position will include both clinical responsibilities and time for academic pursuits. The eight member hematopathology division, which serves the entire UPMC-Health System, is responsible for an adult and pediatric bone marrow service, an adult lymph node service, a flow cytometry laboratory and three general hematology laboratories. The division also is involved in both translational and more basic research activities as well as graduate and post-graduate teaching. Applicants must be board certified in anatomic and/or clinical pathology and board eligible or certified in hematopathology.
