

Academic Transfusion Medicine/Apheresis Position—The Institute for Transfusion Medicine (ITxM) and University of Pittsburgh are now accepting applications for an academic transfusion medicine specialist with particular interest in therapeutic apheresis. This appointment is in the Department of Pathology at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine at the assistant/associate professor level, and involves working within the professional group at the Institute for Transfusion Medicine. The candidate must have an MD degree with board certification in pathology, hematology, or internal medicine; sub-specialty boards or board eligibility in Blood Banking / Transfusion Medicine and experience in managing a large hospital therapeutic apheresis service are highly desirable. Applicants with academic interests in therapeutic apheresis and extracorporeal photopheresis (ECP) are particularly encouraged to apply. Establishing and sustaining a clinical research program is a major duty of the applicant. Clinical responsibilities will include participating in a large integrated multi-hospital therapeutic apheresis and ECP service. Other duties will include participation in the centralized transfusion service and teaching medical students, residents, and fellows in transfusion medicine and hematology/oncology. Academic rank and salary will be commensurate with experience. Eligibility for medical licensure in Pennsylvania is required. Please forward your CV to Darrell J.
