

The Department of Pathology at the Vanderbilt University School of Medicine is recruiting for an Associate Director of Clinical Laboratories. The Vanderbilt clinical laboratories include all the major areas of laboratory medicine and notably, has a very large presence in molecular infectious disease, molecular genetics, coagulation, and hematopathology. The laboratory service provides support to Vanderbilt University Hospital and Vanderbilt Children's Hospital. The position will involve a wide range of clinical responsibilities, as well as teaching and mentoring of residents and fellows in the Department of Pathology and from other Vanderbilt departments. The selected individual will play a major role in the administrative leadership of the Vanderbilt clinical laboratories working closely with the Director of Clinical Laboratories, the department's large and growing outreach laboratory service, and the development of diagnostic management teams to provide advice to physicians on test selection and patient specific narrative reports on complex clinical laboratory evaluations. The rich academic environment at Vanderbilt provides substantial opportunities for clinical and translational research. Applicants should be committed to excellent patient care as well as teaching, scholarship, and research. Candidates must be board certified in clinical pathology and must have or be eligible for a Tennessee Medical License. At least 10 years of experience beyond residency/fellowship experience is required. Academic and administrative accomplishments must support an academic appointment at the associate professor or professor level at Vanderbilt. Salary will be commensurate with the candidate's qualifications.
