A Research Professional Associate position is available as of January 1st, 2011, in the laboratory of Susana R. Marino, MD, PhD, D (ABHI), at the University of Chicago, Department of Pathology.

Participate in training and investigating the role of natural killer cells and killer cell immunoglobulin like receptors (KIR) in hematopoietic stem cell transplantation for one year, not to exceed two years. Perform research in collaboration with the Principal Investigator, research scientists and lab personnel.

MD, Ph.D., or M.D/PhD in biological sciences required. Excellent graduate training and a record of publications in immunology/molecular biology/cancer biology preferred. Experience in HLA and Immunobiology, natural killer cell and T-cell biology, and molecular biology is highly desired. Proficient knowledge of micro-computer word processing, spreadsheet and database software used in scientific research necessary. Ability to write and verbalize clear and complete research findings in the English language. Evidence of past accomplishments including papers published in English language journals and high quality thesis.
