

**Investigative Molecular Diagnostics Position** – The Department of Pathology, Division of Molecular Diagnostics, at the University of Pittsburgh, is seeking an academic investigator. The position will include appointment in the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine as Assistant, Associate, or full Professor as appropriate for the candidate. Candidates must have an M.D. with appropriate board certification/eligibility and qualify for an unrestricted Pennsylvania medical license. Prior experience in a large hospital-based molecular diagnostics service and formal molecular fellowship training are beneficial. Applicants are expected to have or develop an externally-funded research program in basic, clinical or translational science or in informatics. Protected time for research is generous, and the area of research need not be linked to clinical duties. Clinical responsibilities will include limited shared laboratory attending duties with four other faculty in a full spectrum integrated multi-hospital molecular diagnostics service performing testing in molecular microbiology, genetics and hematologic oncology. Other duties include focused teaching of residents and fellows in pathology and genetics as well as graduate and medical students. Academic rank, tenure and salary will be commensurate with experience.
